## The Husband and Wives Club: A Year in the Life of a Couples Therapy Group

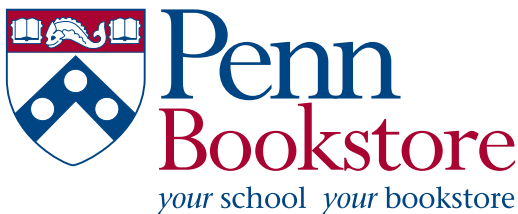
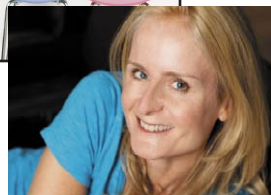
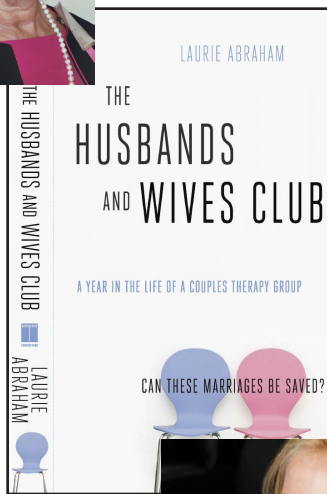
“The Husband and Wives Club,” based on Coche’s “Couples Group Psychotherapy: A Clinical Treatment Model” and her clinical work in couples group therapy, follows five couples through the process of couples group psychotherapy.

Abraham’s work was first published as a New York Times Magazine cover story, “Can This Marriage Be Saved,” and received the Award for Excellence in Journalism from the American Psychoanalytic Association.

Coche has more than twenty-five years of clinical experience. She has achieved certification as a supervising group psychotherapist from The National Registry of Group Psychotherapy, and as a supervising family therapist from the American Association of Marriage and Family Therapy.

Coche is clinical professor of psychology in psychiatry and coordinator of the group psychotherapy residency-training program in psychiatry at Penn’s School of Medicine, and is a clinical associate in the Department of Clinical Psychology at Penn. She holds a diplomate in clinical psychology from the American Board of Professional Psychology.

Abraham is a freelance writer and senior editor of Elle magazine. Her work has appeared in New York magazine, The New York Times Magazine, Mother Jones and other publications.
